# SHORT FILM

- **The film shall not be more than 10 minutes.**
- **Any number of participants can participate.**
- **Only school and college students are eligible.**
- **The recommended ratios are 16:9.**
- **The film must not contain any copyright work (s)**
- **The short film must be original and no watermark of any kind should be on the film.**
- **Film must not contain vulgar words or scenes.**
- **Themes: Art & Culture, Child Labor, Digital India, Environment, Gender Equality, India Heritage, Pollution, Social Harmony & Democracy, Women Empowerment.**
- **Language - Hindi or English.**
- **Films made in language other than Hindi or English language must have English subtitles otherwise they will be summarily rejected.**
- **The short film have to be strictly submitted to coordinators before 1st November 2023.**
- **Poster of film must be submitted at the time of film submission.**
- **Judges' decision will be the final.**



# DOCUMENTARY

- **The time limit is of 12 minutes.**
- **Only school and college students are eligible.**
- **The recommended ratios are 16:9.**
- **Use of offensive language or vulgar content is not allowed.**
- **Films made in language other than Hindi or English language must have English subtitles otherwise they will be summarily rejected.**
- **The documentary film have to be strictly submitted to coordinators before 1st November 2023.**
- **Themes: Art & Culture, Child Labor, Digital India, Environment, Gender Equality, India Heritage, Pollution, Social Harmony & Democracy, Women Empowerment.**
- **Poster of film must be submitted at the time of film submission.**
- **Decisions taken by the judges will be final and binding.**



# PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

- **Participants have to submit only soft copy with higher resolution**
- **Pictures should be only in JPEG format.**
- **Theme of Photography - IMS UC Campus and Event, Each Participants have to submit maximum 2 photograph. Photo should be captured only in IMS UC Campus**
- **Digital manipulation that distort the reality of the image will not be allowed. Only basic enhancements such as sharpening, contrast adjustment, or simple cropping will be allowed.**
- **The Submission deadline is, Same day before 2:00PM**
- **The file name for each image should be clearly labelled with the participant's name, School/College Name and Phone No.**
- **The participants will Submit their Photographs to the coordinators of the event in the campus.**
- **Copied entries, if found with valid proofs, will be disqualified and deleted from the album.**
- **The decisions taken by the conveners of this event in regard to judging and any other issue shall be final and binding.**



# RADIO JOCKEYING

- **Topic will be given on the spot.**
- **Vulgar language or content is not allowed.**
- **Time limit is 3 minutes. In which 1-minute time is for the preparation and 2 minutes for performing.**
- **Judgment will be based on content, confidence, and voice clarity.**
- **Hindi and English both the languages are allowed.**
- **Participants will be judged on the basis of fluency, spontaneity, presentation, sense of humour, communication skills, and interaction with the listeners.**
- **Decision of the judges will be final and binding.**





# DEBATE COMPETITION

- **Topics will be provided on the spot from the following :**

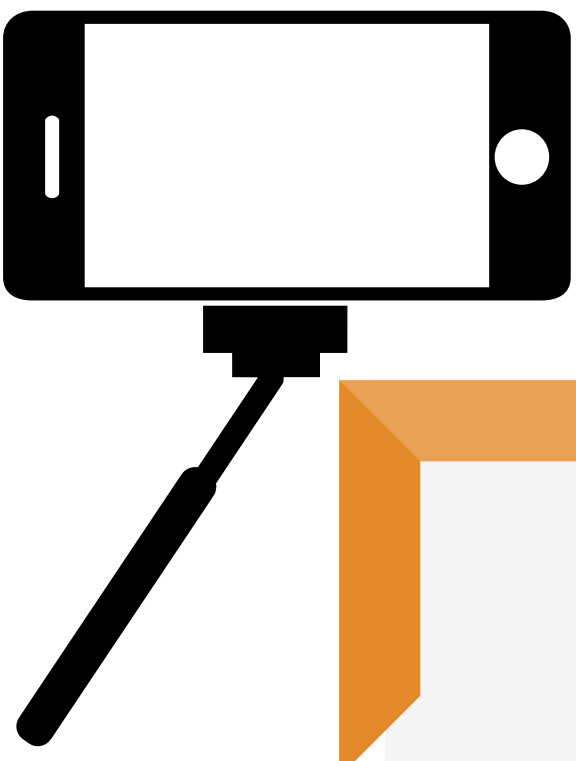
**1. Can artificial intelligence replace human intelligence?**

**2. Freedom of Speech : Are we allowed to say anything?**

**3. One Nation, One Election : Better for Voter? Better for Citizen?**

**4. Is reservation for women justified?**

- **The first speakers from the affirmative and negative sides will introduce the topic and then debate will be started.**
- **Three participants will be available in each team.**
- **Participants will get five minutes before starting the debate to think or discuss on the topics.**
- **No ad hominem (personal) attacks.**
- **Listen carefully to the arguments of your opponent.**
- **Do not interrupt. Let the other team finish their arguments before you begin.**
- **Interrupting a speaker is forbidden. It will cut marks.**
- **The audience must not participate in the debate.**
- **Manage your emotions. Don't let your feelings get the best of you.**
- **You may not agree with the stance you have to take. Try your best and be objective.**



# REELS COMPETITION

- **It must be inside the IMSUC campus & Event.**
- **It should not exceed 30 seconds.**
- **It must be related to the given topic**
- **Every individual should Make their own reel**
- **Music must be decent**
- **Avoid use of Abusive content and language.**
- **It should be uploaded in a 9:16 ratio.**
- **Your reels must be engaging to the audience.**
- **You can also include your face in the reels if needed.**
- **You must be confident in front of the camera.**
- **You can shoot from the Phone/Camera.**
