- 7. No technical support will be provided.
- 8. Teams are allowed to use musical props such as Dholak, Flute, or any other musical instrument of their choice, but usage of mikes, lights, or other electrical instruments is not allowed.
- 9. Team size: Maximum of 12 members including those handling music.
- 10. No professional assistance is permitted, all team members should be certified students of the institute, please bring along your identity cards.
