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## NTA Considering Conducting CUET Twice a Year from Next Session: UGC Chairman

**NEW DELHI:** The Central Universities Entrance Test (CUET) will neither make the board exams irrelevant nor give a push to “coaching culture”, University Grants Commission (UGC) Chairman Jagadesh Kumar said on Tuesday, asserting that students from state boards will not be at a disadvantage in the undergraduate admission process.

The National Testing Agency (NTA), which is responsible for conducting the exams, will consider conducting the CUET twice a year from the next session, he said.

In an interview to PTI, Kumar said CUET will not just be limited



to admissions in Central Universities as several prominent private universities have indicated that they would like to come on board for using the scores from the common entrance exam for undergraduate admissions.

“To begin with CUET will be conducted once this year but

NTA will consider conducting the exam at least twice a year from next session. The entrance exam will not just be limited to Central Universities but also private universities. Several prominent private universities have indicated that they would like to come on board and admit students through CUET,” he said.

Kumar had last week announced that CUET scores, and not Class XII scores, will be mandatory for admission to 45 central universities and the central universities can fix their minimum eligibility criteria.

Asked whether the exam will lead to a “coaching culture” for undergraduate admissions, Kumar said, “The exam will simply not require any coaching so there is no question of it giving push to a coaching culture. The exam will be completely based on class 12 syllabus. Lot of students are getting concerned whether the exam will also have questions from class 11 syllabus. The answer is a clear no”.

## Delhi: Students to go face-to-face as schools set to open fully in offline mode for new session

**NEW DELHI:** The new academic session begins with city schools all to open for in-person classes. With the institutions to run at full capacity after two years, the principals have made seating arrangements and organised welcome programmes, including full-fledged cultural shows.

In most schools, with all students set to return for classes, there will no longer be restrictions on the use of a single desk by two persons. Masks, however, will continue to be mandatory. Some schools have arranged to use the space in the practical rooms for classes. The



schools had reopened earlier after the relaxation of the pandemic norms, but in order to follow Covid protocols, students could be called only in shifts every alternate day.

AK Jha, principal of Government Co-ed Sarvodaya

Vidyalaya, Sector 8, Rohini, said, “We are looking forward to having classes like in the pre-Covid days. We have enough rooms in the school and seating the students will not be a problem.” Most government schools will have two Class IX batches because their exams haven't been held yet.

At ITL Public School in Dwarka, a cultural programme has been planned to welcome the students back. “We thought we should give the students a grand welcome with dance and songs,” explained Sudha Acharya, principal and chairperson of

National Progressive Schools Conference, a consortium of over 400 private institutions. “The school has been disinfected and will be sanitised every day. Wearing a mask will be made compulsory. We also organised a farewell for Class XII on Thursday before their board exam begins.”

Deprived of classes in the company of friends, students too are excited to be returning to school. Friday will also be a special day for those who are going to school for the first time, like for Nishant Gupta's son who will join kindergarten at Bluebells School.

## NEET-UG exam 2022 on July 17, enrolment from April 2022

**NEW DELHI:** This year's National Eligibility-cum Entrance Test (undergraduate) or NEET-UG will be held on July 17 and online registration for the exam has been started on April 2. The single-day pen-paper exam for admission to medical and allied programmes will be conducted in 13 languages.

The registration period is likely to remain open till May 7 and a five-day correction window will be opened in mid-May. Sources at the National Testing Agency (NTA) said that it will notify the exam schedule on March 31, 2022. The exam date was fixed after consultations with the National Medical Commission, the ministry of health and the education ministry, a senior official at the NTA told TOI.

In 2021, a record 16,14,777 candidates registered for the NEET-UG exam, of which 95.6% appeared. A total of 8,70,074 (about 56.4%) candidates qualified the exam. The number of female candidates who qualified the exam was 1.19 lakh higher than the male aspirants. Three candidates were declared joint toppers with a perfect score of 720 marks. Category-wise, close to four lakh OBC candidates qualified the test, while around 2.4 lakh unreserved candidates qualified.

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# सियासी मुद्दों ने फिर ली करवट

हाल ही में संपन्न पांच राज्यों के चुनाव से एक बात तो स्पष्ट हो गई है कि राजनैतिक मुद्दों में बदलाव आ रहा है। अब लोग जाति और स्वहित की लड़ाई को समझने लगे हैं और इस तरह की सियासत करने वाले लोगों को चुनाव में सबक भी सिखा रहे हैं। यही कारण है कि इन पांच राज्यों में किसान और महंगाई के मुद्दे कमजोर पड़ गए और हिंदुत्व और सामाजिक न्याय के मिश्रित कार्यों और मुद्दों को लोगों ने सिर आंखों पर बैठा लिया। हालांकि सच्चाई यह है कि उत्तर प्रदेश की सियासत में हिंदुत्व एवं सामाजिक न्याय के समक्ष विपक्षी दलों ने छद्म सामाजिक न्याय का राग अलाप कर चुनाव को हिंदुत्व बनाम सामाजिक न्याय की लड़ाई के रंग में रंगने की कोशिश की। लेकिन चुनाव के नतीजों ने विपक्ष की मंशा को धराशायी कर दिया।

निःसंदेह, देश भर में पांच राज्यों उत्तर प्रदेश, उत्तराखंड, गोवा और मणिपुर विधानसभा चुनावों में भाजपा ने और पंजाब में आम आदमी पार्टी ने नया रिकॉर्ड बनाया है। केंद्र की राजनीति पर भी इन पांच राज्यों के चुनाव परिणाम का दूरगामी प्रभाव पड़ना



तय है। आगामी राज्यों के चुनाव और 2024 में होने वाले लोकसभा चुनाव पर इसका असर पड़ेगा।

आबादी के दृष्टि से देश के सबसे बड़े सूबे उत्तर प्रदेश में 37 साल बाद किसी दल की सरकार वापस लौटी है। आजादी के बाद ये पहली बार ऐसा हुआ कि अपनी पार्टी को सत्ता में वापसी कराने वाले योगी आदित्यनाथ लगातार दूसरी बार मुख्यमंत्री बने। उत्तराखंड में लगातार दूसरी बार किसी पार्टी की सरकार बनी। वहीं पूर्वोत्तर में मणिपुर और गोवा में भी भारतीय जनता पार्टी की सरकार में वापसी हुई है। दूसरी ओर, सीमावर्ती और संवेदनशील राज्य पंजाब में आम आदमी पार्टी की पहली बार पूर्ण बहुमत की सरकार आई है। आप पहली ऐसी क्षेत्रीय पार्टी बन गई है, जिसने एक राज्य दिल्ली से आगे बढ़कर दूसरे राज्य पंजाब में भी सरकार बनाई है।

नतीजों से स्पष्ट है कि चुनाव में हिंदुत्व का एजेंडा प्रमुख रूप से छाया रहा। महंगाई, बेरोजगारी, किसान आंदोलन, छुट्टा मवेशी जैसे मुद्दे और जातीय समीकरणों के मिथक धराशायी हो गए। विभिन्न राज्यों में कांग्रेस, सपा और अन्य दलों ने महंगाई, किसानों की समस्याओं सहित अनेक मुद्दों को जमकर उछाला। उन्होंने कथित तौर पर जनता को सामाजिक न्याय दिलाने का ढिंढोरा पीटा। लेकिन पंजाब को छोड़कर किसी भी राज्य में इसका असर नहीं हुआ। हालांकि पंजाब में आप की विजयी होने के कई अन्य कारण भी थे। वहां पर सत्तासीन कांग्रेस पार्टी आंतरिक कलह से जूझ रही थी और उसके पांच साल के दौरान किए गए कार्यों के खिलाफ जनता में जमकर आक्रोश था।

उत्तर प्रदेश में चुनाव के दौरान पिछड़े वर्ग के चंद नेताओं ने सपा का दामन पकड़ा और उन्होंने यह इस बाद को भरपूर दर्शाते

का प्रयास किया कि प्रदेश की सियासत में हिंदुत्व बनाम सामाजिक न्याय की लड़ाई आमने-सामने है। लेकिन नतीजों ने इसे छद्म सामाजिक न्यायसाबित कर दिया। चुनावी पंडितों का मानना है कि केंद्र सरकार की अनेक योजनाओं- जन धन योजना, उज्ज्वला योजना, किसान सम्मान निधि, आयुष्मान बीमा योजना, शौचालय निर्माण, आवास रहित लोगों को भवन आदि जैसी अनेक योजनाओं के लाभार्थियों ने दिल खोलकर भजपा को सिर आंखों में बैठा लिया।

ध्यातव्य है कि पश्चिमी यूपी में महिलाओं की सुरक्षा बड़ा मुद्दा रहा। जिस तरह पिछली सपा सरकार में महिलाओं के साथ अपराध बढ़े थे। खासकर उनकी वजह से पश्चिमी यूपी की एक बड़ी आबादी वर्ग के चंद नेताओं ने सपा का दामन पकड़ा और उन्होंने यह इस बाद को भरपूर दर्शाते

मुख्यमंत्री योगी आदित्यनाथ ने भाजपा गुंडागर्दी और माफियाराज की समाप्ति को प्रमुख रूप से मुद्दा बनाया। यही नहीं, मुख्तार अंसारी सरीखे माफियाओं पर कार्रवाई ने भी आम जनता को प्रभावित किया। अभी तक की सरकारों ने अपराधियों के खिलाफ इतनी हिम्मत नहीं दिखायी थी।

इन चुनावों ने यह साबित कर दिया है कि सिर्फ सर्वगं वर्ग ही भाजपा का वोटर नहीं है। जिस तरीके से सपा, कांग्रेस और बसपा ने समाज में जातीय तानाबाना बुनने की कोशिश की, वह पलाप शो साबित हुआ। नतीजे बता रहे हैं कि पिछड़े, अतिपिछड़े और दलित मतदाताओं का भी एक वर्ग भाजपा के साथ आ गया है।

इन पांच राज्यों में हुए चुनाव में सबसे अधिक झटका देश की सबसे पुरानी पार्टी कांग्रेस को लगा है। पांच साल की सत्ता विरोधी लहर (एंटी इनकंबेंसी) के बाद भी कांग्रेस उत्तराखंड, मणिपुर और गोवा में सरकार नहीं बना पाई। इन राज्यों में पार्टी दूसरी सबसे पड़ी पार्टी थी। वहीं उत्तर प्रदेश में अपने तुरूप के इक्के (ट्रंप कार्ड) प्रियंका गांधी वाड़ा को उतारकर भी बेहद शर्मनाक प्रदर्शन का गवाह बनीं। कांग्रेस महासचिव की कड़ी मेहनत रंग नहीं ला पाई। पंजाब में उनकी सत्ता गुटबाजी और कलहों के बीच हाथ से शर्मनाक तरीके से फिसल गई। वहीं कांग्रेस के वोट पसंटेज में भी गिरावट आई।

वास्तविकता तो यह है कि प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी, केंद्रीय गृह मंत्री अमित शाह और उत्तर प्रदेश के मुख्यमंत्री की तिकड़ी ने हिंदुत्व और सामाजिक न्याय की एक ऐसी सोशल इंजीनियरिंग की, जिसको सिर्फ उत्तर प्रदेश की जनता ने ही नहीं, बल्कि उत्तराखंड, मणिपुर और गोवा की जनता ने भी सहाते हुए भाजपा की इन चारों राज्यों में सत्ता का ताज पहना दिया।

## नेहरू संग्रहालय बना पीएम संग्रहालय



**नई दिल्ली।** नेहरू संग्रहालय (नेहरू मेमोरियल म्यूजियम) अब प्रधानमंत्री संग्रहालय (पीएम म्यूजियम) के नाम से जाना जाएगा। देश की राजधानी नई दिल्ली के तीन मूर्ति एस्टेट में स्थित प्रधानमंत्री संग्रहालय का उद्घाटन प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी 14 अप्रैल, संविधान निर्माता बाबा साहेब डॉ. अंबेडकर की जयंती पर करेंगे। यह संग्रहालय 270 करोड़ की लागत के साथ 10,000 वर्ग मीटर क्षेत्र में बनाया गया है।

इस परियोजना को 2018 में मंजूरी दी गयी थी एवं अक्टूबर 2020 तक इस परियोजना को पूरा करने की समय सीमा निर्धारित की गयी थी। 2020 में आयी कोरोना महामारी के कारण, सामग्री की अवधि एवं सविल कार्यों के मुद्दों के कारण यह परियोजना विलंबित हुई।

नेहरू मेमोरियल म्यूजियम में अब तक केवल भारत के पहले प्रधानमंत्री पंडित जवाहरलाल नेहरू से जुड़ी यादों को संजोया गया था, मगर इसे प्रधानमंत्री संग्रहालय नाम देने के बाद देश के सभी

पूर्व प्रधानमंत्रियों से जुड़ी यादों को अब इस म्यूजियम में जगह दी जाएगी। संग्रहालय अब तक सभी 14 भारतीय प्रधानमंत्रियों के जीवन और समय को कवर करता है और उनके योगदान को प्रदर्शित करेगा। संग्रहालय पूर्व प्रधानमंत्रियों की कलाकृतियों और व्यक्तिगत सामानों का एक सही मिश्रण है जो उनके परिवारों और डिजिटल डिस्प्ले से भी एकत्र किया गया है इस संग्रहालय में भाषण, दुर्लभ तस्वीरें, समाचार पत्र, वीडियो क्लिप, साक्षात्कार और मूल लेखन प्रदर्शित किए जाएंगे। इस संग्रहालय में व्यक्तिगत सामान जैसे कैप, पेन, पत्र आदि के साथ-साथ इंटरैक्टिव डिजिटल डिस्प्ले भी प्रदर्शित होंगे। इस संग्रहालय को भविष्य के सभी प्रधानमंत्रियों को भी समायोजित करने के लिए डिजाइन किया गया है।

सूत्रों के मुताबिक दो पूर्व प्रधानमंत्री मनमोहन सिंह और एच डी देवेगौड़ा को इस अवसर के लिए विशेष रूप से आमंत्रित किया जाएगा।

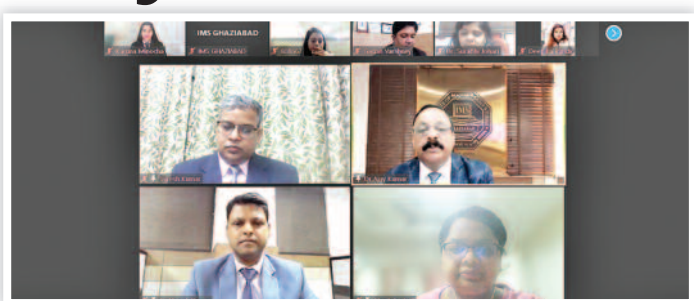
## National Science Day Celebrated by School of Bioscience

## साम्राज्यवादी चीन पर भरोसा करना खतरनाक



चीन के विदेश मंत्री वांग यी के साथ राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा सलाहकार अजीत डोभाल और विदेश मंत्री एस जयशंकर की हाल ही में हुई स्पष्ट गुप्ततू के बाद यह तो पता चलता है कि चीन की मंशा को लेकर भारत सजग है। लेकिन जिस तरीके से यूक्रेन के मामले में चीन अप्रत्यक्ष तौर पर रूस के साथ खड़ा दिखाई दे रहा है, उससे यह इनकार नहीं किया जा सकता कि वह ताड़वान के साथ-साथ भारत के लिए भी संकट बन सकता है। चीन ने यूक्रेन पर रूस के हमले के बाद जिस तरह से अपने रक्षा बजट में 7.1 प्रतिशत बढ़ोतरी की है, उसके बाद भारत को और अधिक सतर्क रहने की आवश्यकता है। ध्यातव्य है कि भारत यात्रा में आए चीन के विदेश मंत्री वांग यी को राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा सलाहकार अजीत डोभाल और विदेश मंत्री एस जयशंकर ने स्पष्ट कर दिया कि पूर्वी लद्दाख में वास्तविक नियंत्रण रेखा से चीनी सैनिकों की पूर्ण वापसी हो और मई 2020 से पहले जैसी स्थिति बहाल की जाए। उसके पश्चात ही दोनों देशों के रिश्ते सामान्य हो सकते हैं। गलवान घाटी में चीनी सैनिकों की घुसपैठ के बाद विदेश मंत्री जयशंकर और वांग की तीन बार दूसरे देशों (रूस और ताजिकिस्तान) में मुलाकात हो चुकी है। सीमा विवाद को सुलझाने को लेकर सैन्य कमांडरों और विदेश मंत्रालयों के बीच वार्ता हो रही है, हालांकि इसकी रफ्तार काफी धीमी है। निस्संदेह, चीन भारत का सबसे घेरेबाज पड़ोसी देश रहा है। 15 मई 2020 में गलवान घाटी में दोनों ही देशों के सैनिकों के बीच जबरदस्त झड़पें हुई थीं और चीन ने वास्तविक नियंत्रण रेखा पर बड़ी संख्या में सैनिकों की तैनाती कर दी थी। यह दोनों देशों के बीच वर्ष 1996 में हुई संधि का उल्लंघन है। यही नहीं, चीन भारत के साथ दोस्ती का नाटक करते हुए भारत पर पहले भी हमला कर चुका है। सीमा विवाद के ही चलते चीन ने वर्ष 1962 में आक्रमण कर दिया था जो दोनों देशों के बीच भीषण युद्ध में तब्दील हो गया था। हालांकि भारत की विदेश नीति गुटनिरपेक्षता पर आधारित रही है। भारत ने खुद किसी शक्ति गुट का हिस्सा नहीं रहा है। वह एक स्वतंत्र विदेश नीति को लगातार आगे बढ़ाता रहा है। यह शीत युद्ध से पैदा हुई नीति है। जब भारत आजाद हुआ था, दुनिया खून खराबे से भरी हुई थी। वैश्विक शक्तियां गुटों में बंटी हुई थीं और संघर्ष को और बढ़ावा रही थीं। कोरियाई युद्ध के दौरान भी भारत और अन्य गुटनिरपेक्ष राष्ट्रों ने इसका पक्ष नहीं लिया था। निस्संदेह, चीन रूस की ओर से प्रत्यक्ष तौर पर यूक्रेन में लड़ाई नहीं लड़ रहा है लेकिन उसने संघर्ष में काफी हद तक रूस का साथ दिया है और उसने इसे आक्रमण कहने से भी इनकार कर दिया है। वहीं अमेरिका ने चीन पर, झूठी खबरें और गलत सूचना फैलाने में रूस की मदद करने का भी आरोप लगाया है। चीन इस मसले पर बाकी देशों से हटकर बर्ताव कर रहा है। यह भी तय है कि अगर महाशक्तियों के बीच विश्व युद्ध छिड़ता है तो चीन रूस के साथ खड़ा होगा। हालांकि भारत चीन के इस रुख से परेशान नहीं है। लेकिन मेरा मानना है कि भारत को चीन के इस स्टैंड को गंभीरता से लेना चाहिए क्योंकि साम्राज्यवादी नीति पर भरोसा करने वाला चीन भारत सहित कई देशों के लिए संकट बन सकता है। चीन के इस स्टैंड से इस बात का डर बढ़ गया है कि वह कभी भी ताड़वान और भारत की सीमा पर आक्रांता के तौर पर घुसपैठ कर सकता है। चीन स्वशासित देश ताड़वान को अपना अधिकार क्षेत्र मानता है और भारत के अरुणाचल प्रदेश सहित कई सीमाई इलाकों को अपना हिस्सा मानता है। अंततः मैं यह कहना चाहूंगा कि चीन के पुराने रिकार्ड को देखते हुए भारत को इसे और अधिक गंभीरता से लेने की आवश्यकता है। परिवर्तित परिस्थितियों में वैश्विक स्तर पर न केवल चीन के खिलाफ माहौल तैयार करने की आवश्यकता है बल्कि अपनी रक्षा नीति का पुनर्मूल्यांकन करते हुए उसको और अधिक चुस्त-दुरुस्त करने की आवश्यकता है।

## Recounting the Horrors of Journalists in Kashmir

Last year, India fell two spots to the 142nd place on Reporters Without Borders' annual World Press Freedom Index, which ranks 180 countries. This year remarkably once again the government has rejected the report citing unfair study. It's a scathing indictment of a country that often brags about its dynamic and competitive media. The picture looks grimmer when you zoom in and take a closer look at the estranged area of Kashmir. As many as 40 journalists in Kashmir have been summoned or raided in the last two years, and they've been required to show themselves to clarify their stories, social media activity, and other societal conduct. According to insiders, the police force has set up numerous divisions to monitor and profile Kashmir-based journalists, the majority of whom work for national or international news organizations. The recent arrest of journalist Fahad Shah might feel as an attack on the fourth estate in India's dwindling democracy to the other half and the world outside but in the violence torn and estranged area of Kashmir, usage of political and

executive force is the new normal. Sajad Gul chronicled the warfare in this hometown, marred with an armed insurrection and a brutal crackdown by the state. He spent 11 days in jail for a video he tweeted after which he was granted bail. Almost instantly the executive body charged him under the strict Public Safety Act which sanctions more than two years of imprisonment. Gul's mother Gulshana has been railing to get her son free. 'He is only a writer,' she says. Manan Gulzar Dar was arrested under a conspiracy theory about a militant group. Manan worked as a freelance photojournalist with reputed agencies such as the Guardian. In his hometown of Batamalo, tired eyes of his parents, Fahamida and Gulzar talk about their son as a fantastic photographer. A longing clings to them as they talk about their son. These conspiracy theories are not new. Nor is the tearing apart of families due to gross arbitrariness. The biggest casualty of the abrogation of Article 370 has been the crackdown on journalistic freedom as it continues to power down the already fraying press freedom.

- We are much more interested in a pragmatic view of AI—one that is applied in very practical and can benefit

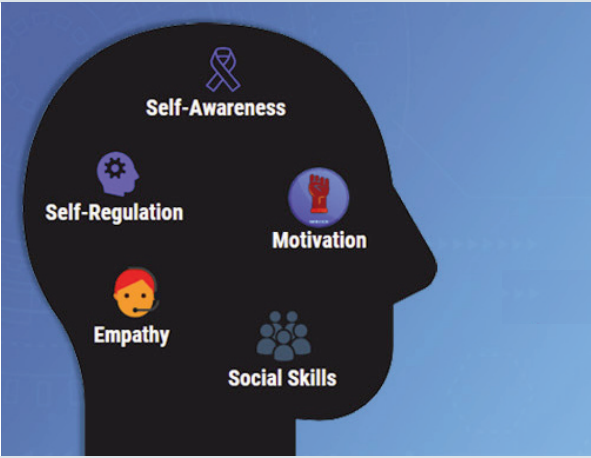

### 3. Emotion AI is Critical to Empathetic and Ethical AI Systems

- Trust and ethics are a huge consideration in AI—one that we take very seriously. This is especially true when we are talking about people's emotions—something very personal.
- If AI systems are expected to make decisions or act on your behalf, what are they allowed to do or not do? Share or not share? If your family robot detects that your teen is showing signs of depression, who should it



disclose to? Building AI systems that have empathy with clear ethical guidelines is critical to the decision-making logic of these AI systems. Emotional intelligence is a key part of that.

### 4. Emotion AI Systems will Augment Human

### Abilities

- Emotion AI systems will augment human capabilities in a way that extends our capacities, making us more productive and efficient.
- Take healthcare for example, where there is a shortage of nurses, clinicians, and mental health workers. Virtual nurses and home-based robots that care for chronically ill patients won't replace the role of the nurse or doctor. Rather they will extend it, providing longitudinal and continuous data on the patient's physical health and emotional well-being.

### 5. AI Systems with Emotion will Create New Job Opportunities

- Robots and other AI systems will take over some of our jobs, but they will undoubtedly create new jobs and opportunities that did not exist before. This has happened over and over in the history of industrialization and automation, and there is no reason to think it will be different in this wave of innovation.

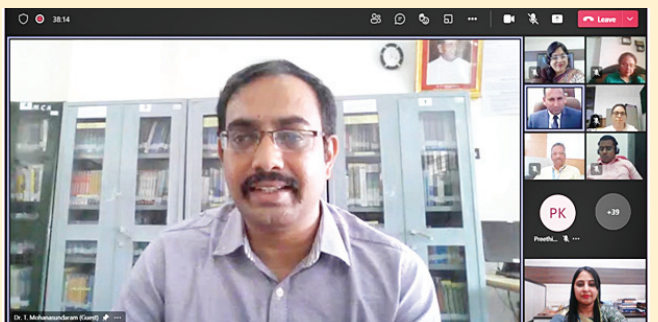
## Seminar on "Innovations in VLSI Technologies"

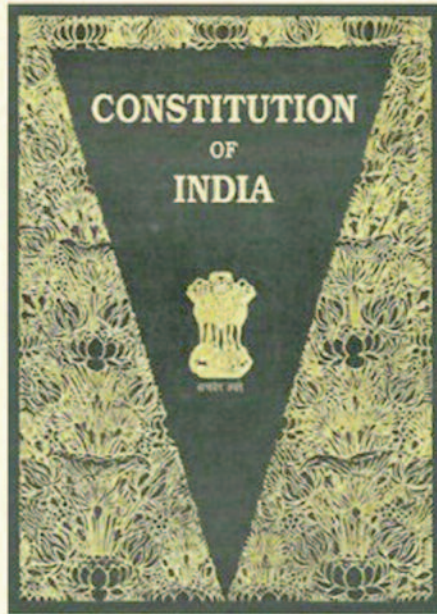
The event was coordinated

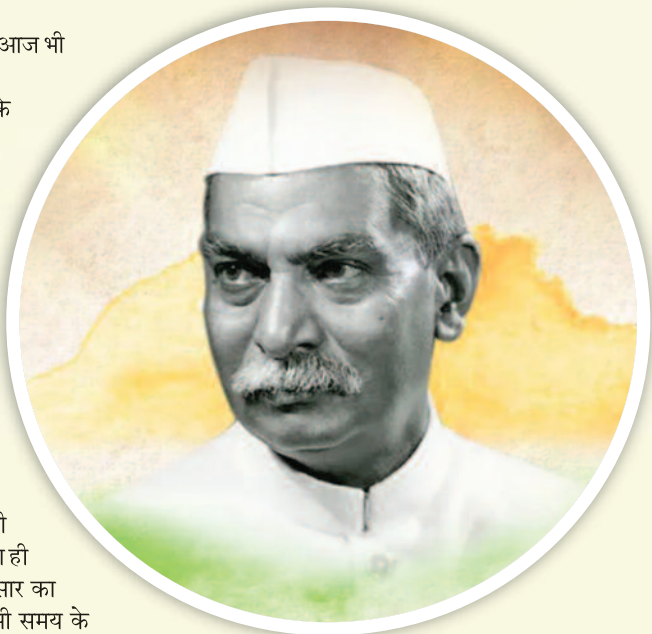
इस संविधान के लागू होने के 3 वर्ष पश्चात ही डॉ. अम्बेडकर को ये अनुभूति होने लगी कि इस संविधान के कुछ पक्ष दोषपूर्ण हैं, किसी भी देश के संविधान से ही राष्ट्रीय अस्मिता का परिचय होता है। भारतीय संविधान में भारतीयता का जो पुट स्थित होना चाहिए, उसका अभाव साक्षात् दृश्य होता है।

अंग्रेजों की वो चाल जो तत्कालीन नेता नहीं समझ सके, हमारे देश के संविधान में हमारे लाखों वर्ष के गौरवशाली इतिहास को स्मरण कराने के उद्देश्य से भारत को इंडिया लिखकर दर्शाया गया। मानसिक दासता का प्रतीक India that is BHARAT संविधान के एक अनुच्छेद में उल्लेखित है।

समस्त भारतीय अभिलेखों में हमारे देश का नाम भारत, आर्यावर्त तथा जम्बूद्वीप है। अत्यंत पुरातन एवं सनातन नाम है भारत, इस नाम से ही राष्ट्र की स्वर्णिम यादें दृश्य पटल पर आपतित होती हैं, गौरव की तीव्र अनुभूति होती है। नाम का जो महत्व होता है जिसकी भरपाई किसी भी वस्तु से नहीं की जा सकती है। लार्ड मैकाले की शांति योजना भारत को इंडिया बनाने की थी, जिसकी गलती तत्कालीन नेताओं से हुई। जिसके परिणामस्वरूप संविधान लागू होने के एक लंबे कालखंड के व्यतीत होने के पश्चात भी अंग्रेजी भाषा

का एक मजबूत वर्चस्व आज भी अपने देश में है।

अनेक प्रयासों के बाद भी किसी भी न्यायलय में हिंदी भाषा को प्राथमिकता नहीं दी जा सकी है। सभी सरकारी वेबसाइटें, उच्च शिक्षा का माध्यम तक अंग्रेजी भाषा में ही है। अंग्रेजी में ही हमारी प्रगति सुनिश्चित है इस तुच्छ मानसिकता का त्याग करके हमें अपनी मातृभाषा को बढ़ावा देना ही होगा। यदि परिवर्तन संसार का नियम है तो परिवर्तन भी समय के अनुकूल ही होना चाहिए। संविधान में आवश्यक संशोधन हमारे राष्ट्र की सजीवता को प्रमाणित करता है, यहाँ तक कि अम्बेडकर के जीवन काल में भी अनेक संशोधन हो चुके हैं। यदि आवश्यकता है तो संशोधन निश्चित ही होना चाहिये। ये कोई नई बात नहीं है। अनेक देशों में संविधान की समीक्षा एवं संशोधन समय-समय पर होते रहे हैं। भारत का संविधान बहुत ही लचीला है। भारतीय संविधान के उद्देशिका में लिखा है कि हम भारत के लोग भारत को एक सम्पूर्ण प्रभुत्व सम्पन्न, समाजवादी, पंथनिरपेक्ष, लोकतन्त्रात्मक गणराज्य बनाने के लिए तथा उसके समस्त नागरिकों को सामाजिक, आर्थिक और राजनीतिक न्याय, विचार, अभिव्यक्ति, विश्वास, धर्म और उपासना की



स्वतंत्रता प्रतिष्ठा, अवसर की समता प्राप्त कराने के लिए तथा उन सब में व्यक्ति की गरिमा और राष्ट्र की एकता और अखण्डता को सुनिश्चित करने वाली बन्धुता बढ़ाने के लिए दृढ़ संकल्प होकर इस संविधान को अंगीकृत करते हैं। परंतु इतने वर्षों के बाद भी समस्त नागरिकों की सामाजिक प्रतिष्ठा और आर्थिक स्थिति समान नहीं हो सकी है। सामाजिक समरसता के उद्देश्य से आर्थिक संतुलन बनाये रखना ही वर्तमान की सबसे बड़ी आवश्यकता है। स्वतंत्र विचार की आड़ में कुछ राष्ट्र विरोधी तत्व भ्रंतियाँ फैलाते हैं और समाज को तोड़ने का कार्य करते हैं।
