No Possibility of Postponement of NEET UG 2022: Education Minister

DELHI: NEET 2022- Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has finally broken silence on the demands of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) (Undergraduate) 2022 postponement. Hinting at there is no possibility of postponement of the NEET UG 2022, the education minister made it clear for the candidates that medical entrance exam will be conducted as it is scheduled. There have been demands on social media with #PostponeNEETUG2022 trending from so many days. At a



media event held this week, education minister pointed out that NEET 2022 is unlikely to get postponed.

As the discussion on NEET UG 2022 postponement goes ahead on social media with

aspirants and authorities on opposite ends, there are some candidates who still think that there are chances that the entrance examination might get postponed. NEET 2022 postponement requests continues

on social media with education minister, National Testing Agency (NTA), Prime Minister Narendra Modi and others being tagged. On the other side, NTA released the NEET 2022 exam city slips on June 29, 2022 hinting that the NEET UG admit card 2022 is likely to be released anytime soon. As of now, NEET 2022 will be conducted as per the schedule on July 17, 2022 for all the candidates. Candidates are advised to keep a close check here and on the official website for latest updates related to NEET UG 2022.

Uttar Pradesh: 'Link 2 crore kids with School Chalo drive'

LUCKNOW: Laying importance on school education, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath directed officials to ensure that no child is left out of school.

Chairing a meeting, the CM said education empowers people to take the right path and lay the foundation of a developed and empowered country. He asked officials to make the 'School Chalo Abhiyan' campaign more effective. "Children from each and every family must go to school on a regular basis," the CM said. He also urged parents to ensure they sent their kids to school in proper uniform. Yogi led government has set a target to connect two crore children aged 6-14 years.

CUET-UG 2022 Exams till August 10

NEW DELHI: With an aspirant being allowed to appear in upto nine papers, resulting in 54,000 subject combinations, the Common University Entrance Test-Undergraduate (CUET-UG) will be the longest entrance exam to be conducted from July 15 to August 10, 2022. Over 11 lakh candidates have registered for the first edition of CUET.

As per the notification released on Wednesday, CUET-UG will spread over 10 days starting from July 15. There will be no CUET papers on July 17, 2022 due to the NEET-UG and between July 21 to August 3 due to the JEE (main) exams. All these national-level entrance exams are conducted by the NTA. The exam will be conducted across 554 cities in India and 13 cities outside India. The University Grants



Commission in March announced that CUET-UG scores and not Class 12th marks would be mandatory for admission to 45 central universities and that the central universities can fix their minimum eligibility criteria too. A total of 44 Central Universities, 12 State Universities, 11 Deemed Universities, and 19 Private Universities are conducting their

undergraduate admissions to the 2022-23 academic sessions based on CUET scores. The exam will be conducted in a Computer-Based Test (CBT) mode. Under the CUET-UG scheme, an applicant has to take a language test and can opt for an additional language test depending on the admission requirement of specific universities. Candidates can also choose upto six domain specific subjects and an optional general test.

It will be held in 13 languages namely Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Gujarati, Odiya, Bengali, Assamese, Punjabi, English, Hindi and Urdu. Additionally, a candidate can also pick from 19 other languages such as French, German, Japanese, Russian, Bodo, Santhali and many more.

students energized and eager to learn. Not denying that it has led to a digital divide where the children in far flung remote areas and even in cities have been deprived of learning, more so due to an economic divide as everyone is not privileged to have the gadgets to facilitate virtual classes.

Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Day 2022:

The month of June is known as the Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month. This month the Alzheimer's Association joins hands with people worldwide to encourage awareness about Alzheimer's and Dementia through fundraisers, events and educational material. June 21 is considered Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Day. This day is designed to show love and support to people impacted by Alzheimer's. All month long and especially on June 21, people are encouraged to wear purple as a symbol of support and create awareness regarding Dementia and Alzheimer's care. To continue with the tradition of spreading awareness, here are the most

Addressing the misconceptions around Alzheimer's

commonly misunderstood aspects of Alzheimer's:

Myth 1- Alzheimer's disease and Dementia are the same things

Alzheimer's and Dementia are two interchangeably used terms but they are not the same. Dementia is not a disease. It is an umbrella term for many symptoms like declining memory, poor judgment and reasoning, decreased focus, etc. On the contrary, Alzheimer's is a disease and the most common form of dementia nevertheless it is not the only one. There are other forms like Mixed dementia, Huntington's disease, etc.

Myth 2- Memory loss is the first detectable symptom of Alzheimer's

The general notion among people is that the first sign of Alzheimer's is memory loss. However, there is growing evidence that Alzheimer's begins its attack on the brain way before the identifiable symptoms set in.



Scientists at Neurogenerative Disease Research imaged an individual's brain over time. They found amyloid protein as one of the earliest markers of Alzheimer's. Over 20-30% of adults with no memory loss symptoms had deposition of amyloid protein in their brain. This suggests that the disease can be identified before severe symptoms occur.

Myth 3- Alzheimer's only occur in old people

Alzheimer's is more common in people above the age of 65 but it

can also affect people before this age. Alzheimer's occurring in people under the age of 65 is called early-onset Alzheimer's disease. According to the Alzheimer's Association, almost 6 million people are living with Alzheimer's in America. Among these 5-6%, i.e., 300,000 to 360,000, are below the age of 65.

Myth 4- Alzheimer's is indiscriminate disease

Most people believe that Alzheimer's is an indiscriminate disease. It is likely to affect all groups equally irrespective of their race, profession, etc. However, it turns out that the life of a privileged person (high social class and financial security) has some level of limited protection against Alzheimer's. A study by Yaakov Stern of Columbia University involving 593 people found that those who were less educated and held lower-status jobs developed Alzheimer's at an early age than others. This initial advantage later faded because

highly educated individuals condition declined faster after developing Alzheimer's.

Myth 5- Alzheimer's disease can be prevented

The idea that specific brain exercises or supplements can prevent Alzheimer's has no credible scientific evidence behind it. According to an exhaustive review of brain training programs by a group of scientists led by Daniel Simons, the effects of these programs are negligible. Alzheimer's is a severe brain disease that has hampered the lives of millions. Even though a drug being tested for slowing down brain degeneration has failed the initial drug trials. A serious medical effort is going on to find suitable treatment for the patients. Before that the society needs to be clear on the fundamentals to reduce the stigma around it. This Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Day we should pledge to increase our understanding of Alzheimer's and Dementia.

वर्षों तक चुकानी होगी हिंसा की कीमत

केंद्र सरकार की युवाओं के लिए सेना में भर्ती की अग्निपथ योजना को लेकर देश के विभिन्न हिस्सों में हिंसक प्रदर्शन करने और राष्ट्रीय संपत्ति को क्षति पहुंचाए जाने से देश के विकास को गंभीर क्षति पहुंची है। युवाओं के जो हाथ राष्ट्र व समाज के निर्माण के लिए उठने चाहिए, वे हाथ राष्ट्र की संपत्ति को जलाने और नष्ट करने के लिए उठे हैं। युवाओं को समझना चाहिए कि उन्होंने हिंसा के माध्यम से बसों, ट्रेनों और कार्यालयों को नहीं जलाया, बल्कि उन्होंने अपने घर की संपत्ति को आग के हवाले किया है। अगर यह कहा जाए कि वे जिस डाल पर बैठे हैं, उसी को काट रहे हैं, तो इसमें कोई अतिशयोक्ति नहीं होगी। देश को इसकी कीमत कई वर्षों तक चुकानी पड़ेगी। युवाओं को इस ओर ध्यान देने की जरूरत है कि कुछ समाज एवं राष्ट्र विरोधी तत्व सोशल मीडिया के माध्यम से अग्निपथ योजना की गलत एवं भ्रामक व्याख्या कर उनको दिग्भ्रमित कर रहे हैं।

ध्यातव्य है कि भारतीय सशस्त्र बलों में भर्ती से संबंधित अग्निपथ योजना में चयनित उम्मीदवारों को चार साल की अवधि के लिए थल सेना, वायु सेना और नौसेना में अग्निवीर के रूप में काम करने का मौका मिलेगा। सेना में चार साल की अवधि पूरी होने पर ये अग्निवीर एक अनुशासित और एवं कुशल श्रमशक्ति के रूप में विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में करियर बना सकते। इन्हीं अग्निवीरों में 25 फीसद लोगों को सेना में नियमित कर दिया जाएगा। शेष युवाओं को पुलिस, सीमा सुरक्षा बल सहित विभिन्न सिविल नौकरियों की भर्ती में सरकार प्राथमिकता देगी। यहां तक कि कारपोरेट सेक्टर की भर्ती में अग्निवीर का कार्य कर चुके युवाओं को वरीयता देने की बात कही गई है।

अग्निपथ योजना के तहत प्रारंभिक तौर पर सेना में कुल भर्ती प्रक्रिया की मात्र तीन फीसद भर्ती की जाएगी जबकि 97 फीसद भर्ती पूर्वतन जारी रहेगी। हालांकि बाद में इसको बढ़ाया जाएगा लेकिन इस योजना के तहत कुल सेना बल का 50 फीसद से ज्यादा नहीं होगा। आंदोलित और भ्रमित युवाओं को यह समझने की आवश्यकता है कि इस योजना के माध्यम से सेना में रोजगार के अवसर नहीं खत्म किए जा रहे बल्कि इसके माध्यम युवाओं को कुशल श्रम के लिए तैयार कर उनके लिए रोजगार की और अधिक संभावएं उत्पन्न की जा रही हैं। अग्निपथ योजना का सबसे बड़ा लाभ यह है कि देश की सेवा की आकांक्षा रखने वाले लाखों युवा महिला और पुरुषों को सेना में भर्ती होकर राष्ट्र निर्माण में योगदान करने का सुअवसर मिल सकेगा। सशस्त्र बलों में शामिल होने से न केवल देश की सेनाएं सशक्त होंगी, बल्कि इससे युवाओं में अनुशासन, जोश, प्रेरणा, कार्य कुशलता, प्रतिबद्धता, टीम लीडरशिप और देश के प्रति समर्पण जैसे अनेक गुण विकसित होंगे। और जब ये युवा चार साल बाद सिविलियन बन समाज के विभिन्न सेक्टरों में काम करेंगे तो इससे समाज मजबूत होगा और अगर समाज मजबूत होगा तो निस्संदेह यह भारत को एक समृद्ध और सशक्त राष्ट्र बनाएगा। इसीलिए आवश्यक है कि युवा इस योजना को समझे, किसी के सहकार में आकर राष्ट्रीय संपत्ति को क्षति न पहुंचाएं। वे हिंसा का मार्ग छोड़ कर समाज और राष्ट्र को सशक्त बनाने में अपना महत्वपूर्ण योगदान प्रदान करें, इसी में हम सब का हित निहित है।

साइबर हमले से राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा को बड़ा खतरा

विश्व के सबसे बड़े लोकतांत्रिक देश भारत में साइबर अटैक का खतरा बढ़ गया है। पाकिस्तान, चीन और नार्थ कोरिया में बैठे हैकर्स भारत में साइबर अटैक करने की फिराक में बैठे हुए हैं। हैकर्स के निशाने पर भारत की यातायात व्यवस्था, परमाणु केंद्र, भारत की सुरक्षा गृह मंत्री अमित शाह ने भी हाल ही में ‘साइबर सुरक्षा और राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा’ पर आयोजित एक सम्मेलन में इस बात पर चिंता जाहिर की। उन्होंने कहा कि भारत को जो देश सुरक्षित नहीं देखना चाहते, वे उस पर तरह तरह के साइबर हमले करते हैं और कुछ देशों ने तो साइबर सेनाएं भी बना ली हैं। देश का गृह मंत्री अगर किसी विषय पर इस तरह से चिंता जाहिर करें तो निस्संदेह यह चिंतन, मनन और मंथन का विषय है। कहने का आशय है कि भारत की आंतरिक राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा पर साइबर हमला का खतरा मंडरा रहा है।

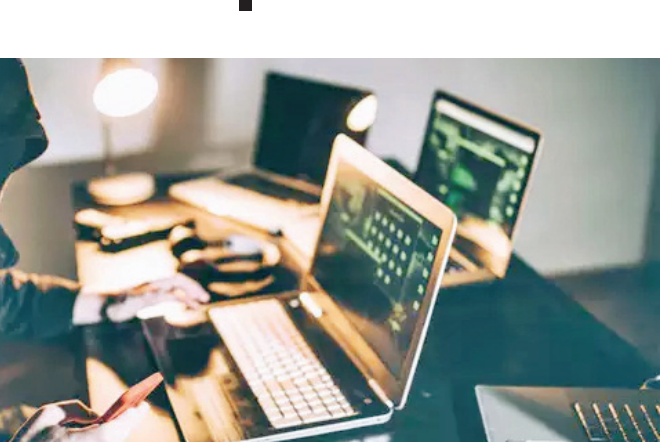
इटैलीजेंस ब्यूरो ने पिछले वर्ष अपनी थ्रेट इटैलीजेंस रिपोर्ट में इस बात का जिक्र किया था कि पहली अक्टूबर से 31 अक्टूबर के बीच देश के महत्वपूर्ण क्षेत्रों में स्थापित कंप्यूटरों को हैक करने का षडयंत्र किया गया था। आज यह साइबर हमला राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा के लए सबसे बड़ी चुनौती बन गया है।

आज इंटरनेट हमारे जीवन में रच-बस गया है। खासतौर से वैश्विक महामारी के आने के बाद तो यह मानव जीवन के लिए आधारभूत सेवा बन गया है। लेकिन यह भी सच है कि इंटरनेट के बढ़ते इस्तेमाल के कारण साइबर अटैक का खतरा बढ़ गया है। अथवा यह कहें कि इसने अटैकर्स के लिए उपभोक्ताओं पर साइबर अटैक करने का काम आसान कर दिया है। भारत इंटरनेट के मामले में विश्व का दूसरा सबसे बड़ा उपभोक्ता है। कुल आबादी का 41 फीसद लोग इंटरनेट का उपयोग करते हैं। डेटा और उपभोक्ताओं की संख्या की दृष्टि से इसमें दिन-प्रतिदिन वित्सार हो रहा है। इसके अलावा इसका इस्तेमाल रक्षा क्षेत्र से लेकर एंफ्रास्ट्रक्चर के हर क्षेत्र में इसका उपयोग होता है। ध्यातव्य है कि जिस प्रकार एक क्षेत्र पर कब्जा

करने के लिए लड़ाई लड़ी जाती है, उसी प्रकार डिजिटल दुनिया में नेटवर्क में घुसपैठ करने की बाबत साइबर अटैक का सहारा लिया जाता है। किसी सिस्टम और उसके डेटा पर नियंत्रण पाने के लिए हैकर्स अनैतिक साधनों का इस्तेमाल करते हैं। अटैकर्स कमजोर सिस्टम पर हमला करने और उस पर नियंत्रण करने के लिए मैलिसस कोड का सहारा लेते हैं।

साइबर सिक्योरिटी पर अटैक अनेक प्रकार से किए जा सकते हैं। इसके लिए मलवेयर, फिशिंग अटैक, डिनायल ऑफ सर्विस, मैन इन द मिडिल के माध्यम से किया जा सकता है। इसको सिस्टम को हैक करने, क्रिटिकैरेंसी के रूप में पैसे की मांग के लिए या फिर डार्क वेब पर डेटा बेचने के लिए इस्तेमाल किया जाता है। इस तरह के हमलों में संवेदनशील एवं महत्वपूर्ण जानकारी जो उपयोगकर्ता के वेबसाइट पर उपलब्ध है, उसे बिना किसी वेबसाइट या यूजर्स के ज्ञान के हाईजैक कर लिया जा सकता है। ऐसा होने से हमारी यातायात व्यवस्था भंग हो सकती है। बिजली टप हो सकती है अथवा परमाणु केंद्रों को आतंकी अथवा हमलावर अपने अनुसार संचालित कर भारत की आंतरिक सुरक्षा में सेंध लगा सकते हैं।

ध्यान रखने की बात है कि सिस्टम अथवा डेटा पर हमला कोई नई बात नहीं है। लेकिन वैश्विक महामारी कोरोना महामारी के बाद वर्क फ्रॉम होम के वर्क कल्चर के चलते दुनियाभर में साइबर हमलों का खतरा ज्यादा बढ़ गया है। एक आंकड़े के अनुसार, पिछले वर्ष जनवरी से जून तक के महीने इस दृष्टि से बहुत खराब रहे। इस अवधि में घरेलू भारतीय कंपनियों पर हर सप्ताह औसतन 1,738 साइबर हमले हुए। ये हमले दुनिया भर में होने वाले हमलों में से सबसे अधिक हैं। जबकि संपूर्ण विश्व में होने वाले हमलों का आंकड़ा महज 757 रहा। निस्संदेह, वर्क फ्रॉम होम की वजह से संपूर्ण विश्व में साइबर अटैक का खतरा बढ़ा है। चेक प्वाइंट्स रिसर्च की 'साइबर अटैक ट्रेंड्स-2021 मिड ईयर' की रिपोर्ट में कहा गया कि भारत में शिक्षा, रिसर्च, सरकार, सेना, बीमा, विनिर्माण, हेल्थकेयर क्षेत्र की कंपनियां पर सबसे ज्यादा साइबर हमले हुए। वैश्विक



स्तर पर हेल्थकेयर को ज्यादा निशाना बनाया गया। वहीं एक नजर भारत में होने वाले साइबर अपराधों पर भी डालना उचित रहेगा। वर्ष 2012 में साइबर अपराध के कुल 3,377 मामले दर्ज किए गए, और 2020 में यह संख्या बढ़कर 50,000 हो गई। जिन साइबर अपराधों की रिपोर्ट नहीं की गई, उनकी संख्या लाखों में हो सकती है। केंद्रीय गृह मंत्री अमित शाह कहते हैं कि गृह मंत्रालय ने लगभग तीन साल पहले साइबर अपराध की सूचना दर्ज कराने के लिए पोर्टल शुरू किया था और अब तक विभिन्न प्रकार के साइबर अपराध के 11 लाख मामले दर्ज किए गए हैं। इसके अलावा, पोर्टल पर सोशल मीडिया से जुड़ी दो लाख से अधिक शिकायतें दर्ज की गईं। साइबर सिक्योरिटी फर्म सर्फशार्क की रिपोर्ट कहती है कि वर्ष 2004 के बाद साइबर हमलों में 14.9 बिलियन से अधिक खोते लीक हो चुके हैं। इनमें से 254.9 मिलियन या 25.49 करोड़ खाते भारतीयों के हैं। भारत में सबसे पहला डिजिटल हमला वर्ष 2004 में हुआ। वास्तविकता तो यह है कि अब यह देश साइबर हमलों का केंद्र बनता जा रहा है। भारत विश्व का छठा सबसे ज्यादा ब्रीच किया जाने वाला देश बन चुका है। रिपोर्ट में कहा गया है कि प्रत्येक 100 भारतीयों में से 18 की पर्सनल कॉन्टेक्ट डिटेल् को ब्रीच किया गया। देश में पिछले 18 वर्षों में डेटा उल्लंघनों के कारण 962.7 मिलियन से अधिक लोगों के कान्टैक्ट डिटेल् डेटा ब्रीच का शिकार हो चुके हैं। आज जो साइबर अटैक अथवा अपराध बढ़ रहे हैं,

उसको रोकने में सरकार की नहीं बल्कि आम उपभोक्ताओं की भी बहुत बड़ी जिम्मेदारी है। ऐसे हमलों को रोकने में उपभोक्ताओं की सजगता और सतर्कता की बहुत बड़ी भूमिका होती है। इसके लिए आवश्यक है कि उपभोक्ता, फोरम या वेबसाइट्स पर अपनी संवेदनशील जानकारी-ईमेल आईडी, पासवर्ड, क्रेडिट कार्ड की डिटेल् शेयर न करें। अपना पास वर्ड मजबूत रखें, कोई भी लिंक क्लिक करने से पहले देखें कि वह वेबसाइट ठीक है। सिस्टम की सुरक्षा के लिए अपने सिस्टम को अपडेट करते रहें और भरोसेमंद सॉफ्टवेयर इंस्टाल करें। भेजे जाने वाले स्पैम मेसेज को खोलने से बचें, ओपन वाई-फाई का इस्तेमाल न करें। साथ ही एक वर्चुअल प्राइवेट नेटवर्क का प्रयोग करें। आप एक सुरक्षित नेटवर्क से जुड़कर और थोड़ी सी सतर्कता और सजगता बरत कर साइबर हमले अथवा अपराध की गिरफ्त में आने से बच सकते हैं।

अंत में मैं कहना चाहूंगा कि भारत में जिस तरीके से सूचना और प्राौद्योगिकी की क्रांति आई है उससे स्पष्ट है कि हम इन क्षेत्रों में दिन प्रतिदिन सशक्त और संपन्न होते जा रहे हैं, लेकिन अंतरराष्ट्रीय मानकों की तुलना में भारत में व्यक्तिगत डिजिटल डेटा की सुरक्षा लचर है। मेरा कहना है कि राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा के मद्देनजर सरकार मौजूदा साइबर सुरक्षा कानूनों की समीक्षा कर उनमें अप्रत्यूत सुधार लाए ताकि देश की सुरक्षा में कोई घुसपैठिया या आतंकी प्रवेश न कर सके।

Collapsed Indian Education System

There is also a need to study entrepreneurial processes of women founded business models and adopt innovativeness in research method choices. So what drives both urban and rural women

towards entrepreneurship? In India, women comprise about 30 percent of corporate senior management positions which is notably higher than the global average (24 percent). The reason behind this is as follows- Whilst jobs provide basic needs at the base of the pyramid like food, water, sleep warmth (pay, cafeteria benefits etc in offices), there seems to be a huge barrier at the next level of the pyramid-Safety. With recurrent sexual harassment and discrimination at the work place a woman feels unsafe, socially discriminated and disrespected (promotions don't come easily). Self-actualization is a far-gone dream for many women who find it difficult to overcome these challenges at the work place. However, the need to self-actualize takes grip once the woman decides to step out of her pre-decided role in a patriarchal system. Whilst the above is not entirely true in all corporates and work environments, it holds true for most others that still believe a woman belongs in the house, kitchen and bed. One of the most obvious reasons to invest in women leaders in India is that women control the vast majority of household spending hundreds yet saving. Another is that women are often better at building long-term relationships. Lasting relationships benefit a business tremendously as only a little can be achieved without trust... with employees, customers, suppliers, shareholders, government, etc. To conclude, self actualization is synonymous with empowerment in women. It is a wheel that has been set in motion. Women are becoming self-aware and command their needs to achieve their highest potential, be recognized, acknowledged, rewarded and respected.

Indian Education System and the Culture of Entrance Exams

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has mandated that all 45 central universities admit students to their undergraduate programs based on the Common University Entrance Test (CUET). The National Testing Agency (NTA) will conduct the test. State and private universities have also been ‘invited and urged’ to follow suit by the UGC. This is another step in the rote learning-based entrance exam culture that the Indian Education System is extensively built on. Right from the Undergraduate Level to the Postgraduate and Occupational Level, students in India are pushed under the cycle of entrance exams that are procedurally meant to test their brilliance by the amount of information they can mug up.

NEET, National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test, previously known as AIPMT is the premier medical examination in the country, is the only way through which a middle class or lower-middle-class student can aim to become a doctor. NEET was first implemented as another firewall to guarantee that only the most qualified students were enrolled in medical education as well as to abolish the practice of collecting capitation fees which fueled corruption. It does,

however, presume that all competitors are competing from the same starting point and under the same limitations. In contrast to the same, medical entrance examinations in the US and UK do not rely on a single three-hour test to grade students, rather take cognizance of their performance throughout their schooling. Moreover, their tests are based on subjective formats that do not just check the mugging capabilities but the writing and analytical objectivity of students.

The Joint Entrance Examination,

JEE is another premier entrance exam that provides the prospect of a seat in the top engineering colleges of the country, the IITs. The coaching culture in the country is a gift of the very same entrance examination. The price that students pay to crack the exam is grossly unacceptable. The learning system is so far compromised in these coaching classes that Mathematics becomes only FITJEE Mathematics and Physics becomes Resonance Physics. The goalposts of learning are shifted to become goalposts to an IIT seat and students run behind artificial high scales test scores while losing the most important years of learning and growing

simultaneously.

CUET is another step in the direction that will propagate and push students into the unguided race of a college seat rather than education. The justification that it will provide a level playing field for all students and resolve the issues that rendered the conventional board exams problematic is vividly inappropriate. The issue is with the board exams, not with the admissions process, which was based solely on their test scores. The solution is to address the problems connected with board examinations. Tests for engineering and medical schools have persisted for years solely on the basis of the ‘equal playing field’ and ‘board

grades are not reliable’ justifications. Entrance Exams especially the ones based on the multiple-choice format and that do not cater to cognitive skill testing will never be an apt enough measure to assess the students. The pressure mounting, unhealthy exam culture in India, that has been pushing students to the brink needs to stop and redressed.

Effective education does not try to turn young students into reckless strategists and ultra-exam-warriors nor does meaningful learning focus solely on exams. As a result for true transformation, we must look beyond the entrance exams and concentrate on education quality and artistically refined teaching.

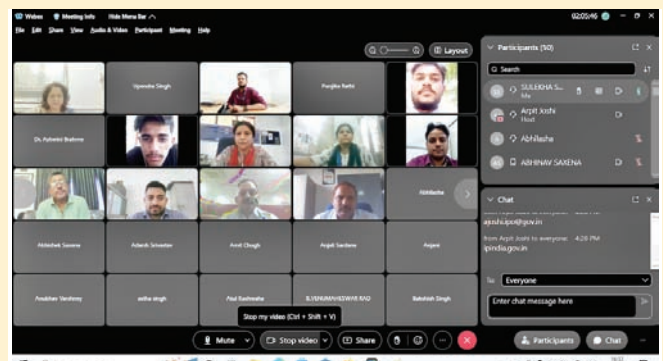

Faculty Awareness Program on IPR Filing Process



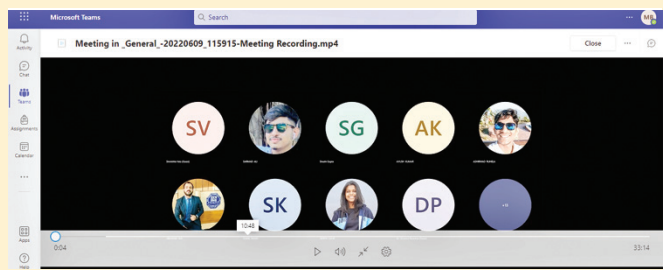

Understanding (LOU) Signing Ceremony

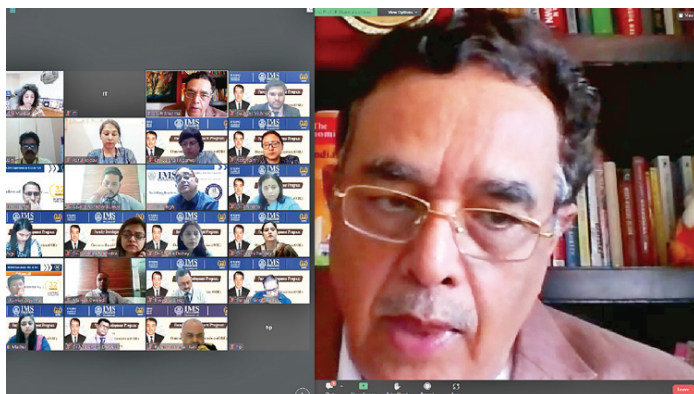

एंथोलॉजी भारतीय सिनेमा का भविष्य

भारतीय सिनेमा में विभिन्न चुनौतियों के अनुसार स्वयं को बदलने की प्रवृत्ति मौजूद है। जहाँ वह सामाजिक एवं सांस्कृतिक विकास के उत्प्रेरक के तौर पर कार्य करता है, वहीं दूसरी तरफ अपनी शैली में बदलाव कर दर्शकों के मनोरंजन का ध्यान भी रखता है। भारतीय सिनेमा ने दुनिया में चल रहे प्रौद्योगिकी विकास के साथ खुद को जोड़े रखा और उससे होने वाले सामाजिक और वैश्विक परिवर्तन के अनुरूप अपनी शैली को बदला है।

इंटरनेट क्रान्ति और ओटीटी के दौर ने सिनेमा को पुनः परिभाषित किया है। आज दर्शक लम्बी अवधि की फिल्में देखना पसंद नहीं करता। उसमें याथार्थ से जुड़ी कहानी में रुचि विकसित हुई है और यही वजह है की एंथोलॉजी (लघु फिल्म निर्माण शैली) भारतीय सिनेमा के विकास के लिए मील का पत्थर साबित होगी। भारतीय सिनेमा के लिए ये शैली कोई नई नहीं है।

पिछले दशक में फिल्मों में एक नया चलन देखा गया क्योंकि फिल्म निमाताओं ने एक प्रयोग के तौर पर डरना मना है (2003), दस कहानियां (2007), आई एम (2010) जैसी फिल्मों से भारतीय दर्शकों को सिनेमा के इस नए प्रारूप से परिचित कराया, जिसे एंथोलॉजी फिल्मों के

रूप में जाना जाता है। एंथोलॉजी देखना एक अनूठा अनुभव है, 'दर्शकों को एक कहानी को देखने के बजाय, अलग-अलग शैलियों में पांच अलग-अलग लघु कथाएँ देखने को मिलती हैं जो दिलचस्प भी है। ऐसा करने से आपको फिल्म निमाताओं को एक संयोजन मिलता है और फिर वे असाधारण अभिनेताओं को एक साथ लाने में सक्षम होते हैं। ये दर्शकों का मनोरंजन करते हैं। इंटरनेट के दौर में एंथोलॉजी युवा प्रतिभाशाली निर्देशकों को एक मंच प्रदान करती है।

निमाताओं और अभिनेताओं को एक ही विषय के भीतर अद्वितीय कहानियों को संयोजित और उसके वर्णन करने की विभिन्न शैलियों को विकसित करने की अनुमति देती है तो वहीं दूसरी तरफ फिल्म निमाताओं को एक पूर्ण फीचर फिल्म की अपेक्षा अधिक रचनात्मक होने का मौका देती है। वास्तविकता तो यह है कि यह प्रारूप



फिल्म निमाताओं को स्वतंत्रता भी प्रदान करेगा, साथ ही कथा और कथानक और रचनात्मकता प्रदान करते हुए दर्शकों को बोझिल मनोरंजन से भी बचाएगा। एंथोलॉजी ने भारतीय सिनेमा को एक नया आयाम प्रदान करते हुए भारतीय क्षेत्रीय

सिनेमा को भी एक माले में पिरोकर नई प्रतिभाओं को एक मंच प्रदान करते हुए फिल्म निर्माण और वितरण की नई तकनीकों के साथ एक नया प्रयोग किया है। इसने वैश्विक दर्शकों के बीच में भी अपनी पहचान बनाना शुरू कर दिया है। लघु

फिल्मों को कोविड-19 महामारी के दौरान और उसके बाद तेजी से विस्तार मिला है। फिल्म निमातां फिल्म से जुड़े संसाधनों के अभाव की बेड़ियों को तोड़कर फिल्म निर्माण कर रहे हैं। ये फिल्में सामाजिक मुद्दों के इर्द-गिर्द घूमती हैं। यही कारण है कि

दर्शकों में लघु फिल्मों की सामग्री के प्रति अधिक आकर्षण पैदा हुआ है। यही बात निमातांओं को और सृजनात्मक बना रही है और सिनेमा में मूल तत्वों में नए प्रयोग की अनुमति दे रहा जो भारतीय सिनेमा के भविष्य के लिए अच्छा संकेत है।

मुलाए नहीं भूलता सिनेमा का वह दौर

एक था दौर जब बॉलीवुड एक इंडस्ट्री कम और वह जगह अधिक थी जहाँ अलग-अलग क्षेत्रों के ढेर सारे कला प्रेमी एकत्रित होते थे और खुद को अपनी कला के प्रति समर्पित कर देते थे।

आज बॉलीवुड फिल्म इंडस्ट्री अपने बुरे दिनों से गुजर रही है। आज उसकी तुलना हर दूसरे फिल्म इंडस्ट्री से की जा रही है और हर जगह जब उसे ही भला-बुरा सुनाया जा रहा है। ऐसे में याद आता है वह दौर जब बॉलीवुड फिल्म इंडस्ट्री का सूर्य अपने सबसे शोभायमान स्थिति में था, और उसके द्वारा बनाई गई फिल्मों ने केवल देश-विदेश में सराही जाती थीं, बल्कि वे फिल्में देश की तत्कालिक सामाजिक एवं राजनीतिक परिस्थितियों को भी प्रतिबिंबित करती थीं।

वर्ष 1940 एवं वर्ष 1960 के मध्य का समय, बॉलीवुड का स्वर्णिम युग कहा जाता है। इस दौर में जो फिल्में बनीं, जिन लोगों ने फिल्में बनाईं, सभी अमर हो गए। उस दौर के फिल्म निर्देशक, अभिनेता, गीतकार अथवा संगीतकारों का नाम इतिहास में स्वर्णाक्षरों में अंकित हो गया है।

इस दौर ने हमें सत्यजीत रे, मेहबूब खान, बी.आर चोपड़ा, बी. शांताराम, बिमल रॉय, गुरु दत्त, राज कपूर एवं श्रद्धिंक घटक जैसे अद्भुत निर्देशक दिए, जिन्हें आज भी दुनिया के सबसे अच्छे फिल्म निमाताओं के रूप में जाना जाता है।

सिनेमा प्रेमियों के लिए सत्यजीत रे अपने-आप में कभी न खत्म होने वाले एवं अविस्मरणीय शिल्पियत के रूप में सुविश्यात हैं। उन्होंने उस दौर में ही (1955-1960 के मध्य) 'द अपू' नामक त्रयी (ट्रियोलॉजी या तीन फिल्मों की श्रृंखला) बनाई जिसमें तीन फिल्मों के माध्यम से एक व्यक्ति के पूरे जीवन को दिखाया गया, ये फिल्में पाथेर पांचाली (1955), अपराजिता (1956), एवं अपूर संसार (1959) थीं, जिनमें उस वक्त के



समाजिक जीवन को पूरी गम्भीरता और वास्तविकता के साथ दिखाया गया। बुसान अंतरराष्ट्रीय फिल्म महोत्सव वर्ष 2015 में अपनी 20वीं वर्षगांठ के दौरान एशिया की सबसे बेहतरीन 100 फिल्मों की जब सूची बनाती है तो उसमें 'द अपू त्रयी' को शामिल करती है। भारत रत्न सम्मानित सत्यजीत रे को वर्ष 1992 में फिल्म जगत के सबसे सम्मानित पुरस्कारों में से एक 'ऑस्कर ऑनोरी अवॉर्ड फॉर लाइफटाइम अचीवमेंट' से पुरस्कृत किया गया।

आज भारत के लोगों में ऑस्कर को लेकर काफी दिलचस्पी रहती है और अगर कोई भारतीय फिल्म इस पुरस्कार के लिए नामांकित भी हो जाती है तो वे उत्साहित हो

उठते हैं, परन्तु मेहबूब खान द्वारा निर्देशित फिल्म मदर इंडिया (1957) न केवल 'बेस्ट फरिन लैंग्वेज फिल्म' की कैटेगरी में नामांकित हुई थी बल्कि सिर्फ एक वोट के अंतर से पुरस्कार जीतने से रह गयी थी, मदर इंडिया उस वक्त भारत की सबसे अधिक कमाई करने वाली फिल्म थी, यह वह दौर था जब अंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तर पर सराही जाने वाली फिल्में, पुरस्कार पाने वाली फिल्में, एवं सबसे ज्यादा कमाई करने वाली फिल्में एक ही हुआ करती थीं।

इस दौर ने हमें ऐसे ही ढेरों उत्कृष्टफिल्में दीं, गुरु दत्त निर्देशित 'प्यासा' (1957), बिमल रॉय निर्देशित 'दो बोधा जमीन',

(1953), राज कपूर निर्देशित 'आवारा' 1951, एवं के. आसिफ निर्देशित 'मुगल-ए-आजम' (1960) उन फिल्मों की फेहरिस्त में बस कुछ चंद नाम है।

अभिनेता या अभिनेत्रियों की बात करें तो राज कपूर, नरगिस, सुरैया, दिलीप कुमार, देवानंद, वहीदा रहमान, नूतन, एवं गुरु दत्त जैसे कलाकारों से सुसज्जित इस काल में मुहम्मद रफी, लता मंगेशकर, एवं किशोर कुमार जैसे गायक हुए जो मजरूह शुल्तानपुरी, एवं साहिर लुधियानवी जैसे गीतकारों के लिखें गीतों को गुनगुनाते थे, जिनमें हर तरह के गीत शामिल होते, चाहे वो कोई फसल लगाते वक्त गाया गया गीत हो या उन्हें काटने पर, घर में बच्चे होने पर गये जाने वाले सोहर गीतों से लेकर किसी का देहान्त होने पर बजने वाले शोक गीत। हर एक त्योहार को मनाए जा सकते थे, हर एक



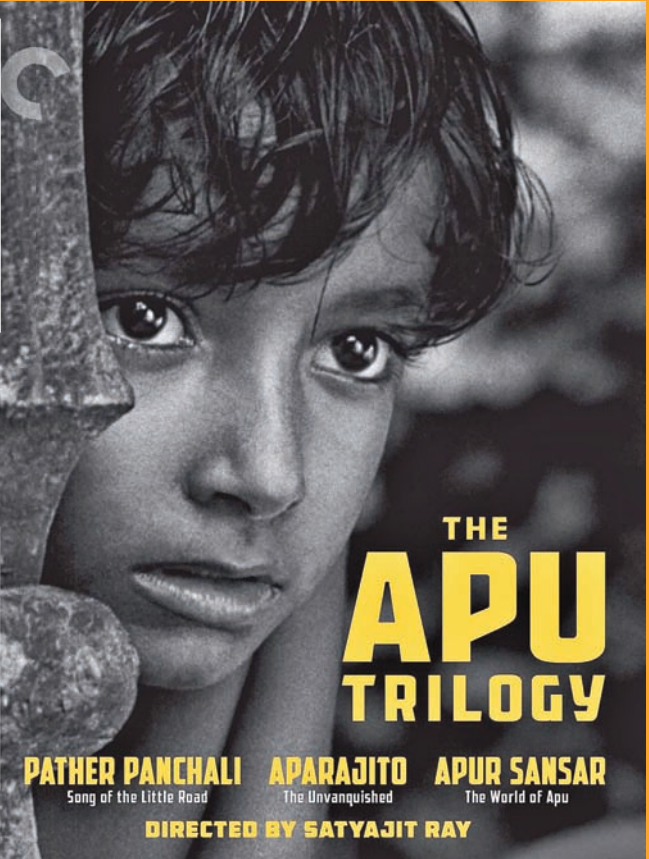
भाव जो महसूस किए जा सकते थे, उन सब के लिए गीत होते थे, और गीत भी ऐसे जो समय के बंधन से मुक्त थे। जैसे जैसे दिन गुजरते गए, ये गीत और अधिक लोकप्रिय होते गए।

इसी दौर में हमने फिल्मों एवं इन्हें बनाने वालों को सराहने एवं सम्मानित करने के लिए दो पुरस्कारों की परम्परा की शुरुआत की।



ये पुरस्कार थे भारत सरकार द्वारा प्रायोजित 'नेशनल अवार्ड्स' एवं फिल्मफेयर मेगजीन द्वारा प्रायोजित 'फिल्मफेयर अवार्ड्स'।

इस दौर में बॉलीवुड एक इंडस्ट्री कम और वह जगह अधिक थी जहाँ अलग-अलग क्षेत्रों के ढेर सारे कला प्रेमी एकत्रित होते थे और खुद को अपनी कला के प्रति समर्पित कर देते थे, चाहे वो गीतकार हों, अभिनेता, निर्देशक, यानिमातां, सभी के लिए फिल्म एक ऐसा माध्यम बनता जिससे वो खुद को अभिव्यक्त करते। उस समय पैसे कमाने या जल्द से जल्द ढेर सारी फिल्में बना देने की होड़ नहीं लगी रहती थी। फिल्मों को समाज का आईना माना जाता था, और फिल्म निमातां ज्यादातर इस बात का ध्यान रखते थे। गरीबी, छुआछूत, पूँजीवाद, महिलाओं की स्थिति एवं सशक्तिकरण, भारतीय संस्कृति, तेजी से होती आधुनिकरण एवं उससे उत्पन्न होते अवसाद इस दौर की फिल्मों के विषय थे, जो आज के दौर में बिल्कुल गायब से मालूम पड़ते है, आज आम लोगों तक पहुँचने वाली फिल्मों से आम लोगों के मुद्दे, दुख, खुशियाँ, भाव ही लुप्त हैं और यही वजह है कि कला और शिल्प दोनों की दृष्टि से 1940-60 का समय आज से बहुत आगे है।
