- One entry per college.
- It is a team event.
- The time limit for every team would be 10 minutes (Including setup and performance).
- Participants are required to send their sound/ audio 2 days in advance
- Also bring along with them their own copies of soundtracks in standard audio format.
- Vulgarity is strongly prohibited and the <u>TEAM CAN BE DISQUALIFIED</u>. <u>if any content hurting public sentiments is showcased.</u>
- Any form of obscenity will lead to debarring the team.
- The use of cigarettes, alcohol and any unfair means is strongly prohibited.
- Teams will be judged on Costumes, theme of PULSE, Walking stance & Atitude.
- Teams have to bring their own props.
- Kindly ensure to carry your college ID Card.







- A maximum of two people in a team can be allowed for participation.
- Participants can sing the song of their own choice.
- Participant pairs may be composed of both females, both males, or one male and one female.
- Participants must bring instruments or instrumental music with their own to perform.
- The time limit for performance is 2-3 minutes.
- A maximum of two entries per Institute will be considered (First come first served basis).
- The screening will be done on the basis of the number of participants, if required.







- Time allotted for each performance is 2-3 minutes.
- Participants will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- The participants will be judged on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm, and appeal to the audience.
- The participants should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.
- The choice of the song is open to the participants but the song should not have any slang or derogatory language.
- Use of recorded background track is also permitted, but the same has to be submitted to the event coordinator day before the event.
- Obscenity (at the discretion of judges) of any kind is not allowed.







- It's a theme-based rangoli creation competition based on imaginative concepts. The participants will be required to create Rangoli with different colors and materials showing some theme.
- Time Duration: 90 minutes
- Team Strength: Maximum four participants in a team.
- The participants must bring their own materials (dry color, flowers, sand, etc.)
- The participants will not be allowed to refer to any printed material etc. for preparing Rangoli.
- There will be only one round of competition.
- The team will be judged on the basis of presentation, creativity, theme, color combination & description, etc.







- Each individual is expected to bring his/her good quality soundtracks on a portable device (pen drive) on the day of the event and they should also send the same 2 days before the student coordinators on the mentioned email ids.
- The time limit for stage performance is limited to a maximum of 3 min
- There will be a negative marking if the time exceeds.
- The vulgarity of any kind (song selection and Costume) will not be tolerated and it may lead to disqualification of participant.
- A maximum of two entries per Institute will be considered (First come first served basis).
- The preliminary qualifying round will be there depending upon the number of participants. Details and schedule will be informed accordingly.







Rules and Regulations:

(Dance theme selection depends upon the participant's own choice)

- Each Group is expected to bring its own good-quality soundtracks in a pendrive or CD on the day of the event and should also send the same 2 days prior to the coordinators for synchronization.
- The time limit for stage performance is limited to a maximum of 5-6 min. If the performer exceeds the time limit, then judges will take relevant action.
- The maximum number of members in each group will be 20
- Two minutes' time for any kind of stage setting will be provided.
- The vulgarity of any kind will not be tolerated as it may lead to disqualification.
- Only one entry per institute will be entertained.
- No props will be provided by the coordinators. Participants can carry their own props.
- Green rooms would be given for changing purposes.
- The participants will be judged on the basis of their rhythm, formations, synchronization, expressions, costume & overall performance.



GROUP DANCE







THEME: Theme selection depends upon the participant's own choice Rules and regulations:

- The team will comprise eight to twelve members.
- The time allotted for each performance will be 10 minutes.
- There will be a negative marking if the time exceeds.
- Teams can use music, props, jingles, and color codes to create an impact.
- The role-play screening will be judged prior to the final round.
- Only the shortlisted teams will perform on the final day of the event.
- The theme of the play should be socially relevant and highlight political issues.
- The last date for giving their nomination for participation will be informed on the website and college notice board.





Rules & Regulations

- Team Event- A squad of 4 will be allowed
- · Squad must be from same institute
- The squad needs to bring their Institute ID card for verification and a xerox copy of the same will be submitted.
- Physical Presence of the player inside the campus is mandatory during the event.
- Device & Internet will be of the player itself.
- Institute will not be responsible for any issue related to the device or internet breakup.
- The Winner will be on the basis of Survival.





- 1 individual per team (Individual Competition)
- Registrations would be done on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Participants will be divided into groups of 5 each.
- Each group will be given multiple prompts, and each group will be given 1 minute in total to speak on each prompt.
- One member of the group would be selected to speak for the prompt through the drawing of chits.
- While a member of the group is speaking, the other members of the group will have to say 'jam' and point out any - Repetition, Hesitation, or Deviation.





- This is an individual event (No team)
- The theme of PULSE to be kept in mind
- Any extra theme idea will be given on the spot.
- Photograph should be relevant to the theme.
- A maximum of three photographs can be submitted per student
- Photograph should be captured within the campus and no editing & filters can be used.
- Provide technical details of the image.
- Only DSLR Cameras can be used.







Rules and Regulations:

- The team shall consist of two members only.
- Participants will be given 1 hour and 30 min. to show their creativity and 2 minutes to talk about the same.
- The required waste material and stationery like scissors, thread, etc should be brought by the participants.
- Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material, or any second-hand items that otherwise would be thrown away.
- The material would be rejected if not found to be a waste product or a second-hand item.
- No ready or semi-finished model or matter would be accepted by participants in the competition.
- Participants will be judged on Creativity, Utilization of Resources, Artistic composition & design, Eco-friendly rating, Utility of the Product, and Overall Presentation.
- No mobile or Internet means would be allowed to use at the time of the Competition.
- The decision of the judges will be considered final and abiding.

Rules and regulations:

- A family/team should consist of three members.
- Each participant is required to register through the registration link
- The total time of the contest will be one and a half hours.
- There will be four rounds, in case of a tie there shall be a tie-breaker round.
- Repatriation not allowed: Once you have sung a song, you or any other team cannot repeat the same song again.
- Mash-up not allowed: You or any other team are not allowed to sing Mash-ups, every team should sing a single song at one go.
- Start from the beginning: All teams have to start any song from the first line or lyric. You must follow the original song; any modification / own version is prohibited.
- Humming is not allowed: All teams are required to sing with the original lyrics, at least the first two lines of the song that you attempt.
- Play Healthy game: All team is advised to play a healthy game, and no team is advised to use any judgmental statement like singing quality, or skill.
